- d. Riverdale Update – Koboï met with the City of Riverdale on Friday to discuss the possible return of football to the Riverdale field by CCFL. The City was informed of what is needed to be in place for CCFL to return to Riverdale as a game site. A site visit and evaluation is scheduled for June, and no decision has been made at this time. The football and cheerleading programs will return to the area and operate in the same capacity as previous seasons.
